

## Early Childhood Endorsement I - Creativity Series



### **Early Childhood Endorsement Program (ECEP)**

To meet the need for a highly qualified early childhood workforce, the Virginia Department of Social Services (VDSS) has established the Early Childhood Endorsement Program (ECEP). This program is designed to provide a comprehensive foundation of knowledge for working with children of specific ages (infants and toddlers or preschool). The ECEP is a collaboration between the VDSS, the Virginia Community College System (VCCS), and the Community College Workforce Alliance (CCWA).

#### The VDSS Early Childhood Endorsement Program offers four endorsements:

- 1. Infant/Toddler Endorsement
- 2. Preschool Endorsement
- 3. Early Childhood Endorsement I Creativity Series (ECEI)
- 4. Early Childhood Endorsement II Health, Safety, Nutrition Series (ECEII)

#### VDSS Early Childhood Endorsements can be valuable as:

- ✓ Entry-level credentials for employment in the field of early childhood
- ✓ Demonstration of foundation of knowledge working with infants and toddlers/preschool children
- ✓ Supplements to a child-related degree or credential that does not include instruction on infants and toddlers/preschool children
- ✓ Supplements to a degree or credential outside the field of early childhood

Successful completion of courses can also fulfill requirements for teaching licensure renewal, annual licensing, and training for the **Child Development Associate (CDA)** credential.

Participants have two options by which to achieve an Early Childhood Endorsement I - Creativity Series:

#### **OPTION 1 - VDSS SPONSORED COURSES**

The Early Childhood Endorsement I requires completion of the following 13 classroom-based or online courses. The courses can be taken in any sequence.

- Creative Junk for Fun and Learning
- Facilitating Brain Development in Young Children
- Incorporating Creativity into Early Childhood Curricula
- Movin' and Groovin': Using Movement to Help Young Children Learn
- Music in the Early Childhood Classroom
- Observing and Recording the Creative Process in Young Children
- ❖ Pinch, Pull, Twist, and Turn Small Motor Development in Early Childhood
- Promoting Creativity and Including All Children
- Roles of Imagination, Play and Dramatic Play in Early Childhood
- Storytelling in the Early Childhood Curriculum
- Three-Dimensional Creative Activities for Young Children
- Two-Dimensional Creative Activities for Young Children
- Why is Creativity Important?

#### To achieve the Early Childhood I - Creativity Series Endorsement:

- Register to take component courses (see list above)

- 2. Complete all required courses
- 3. Complete course assessments within 4 to 6 weeks of completing the online course
  - Part I is online, through CCWA, and is multiple choice/true-false. Participants <u>must</u> receive a passing score of 70% or higher on all courses.
  - Part II is an independent study demonstrating application of content in a classroom setting
- 4. **Submit** the following materials to CCAVA:
  - ✓ Letter grade for Part I (a print out of your score, that includes your name clearly stated)
  - ✓ Completed written assessment for Part II (for grading)
  - ✓ Early Childhood Endorsement I Creativity Series Application Form
  - √ \$10.00 processing fee for each course submitted for grading, check or money order payable to CCAVA, or through PAYPAL. Fees due with forms and assessment materials.

#### **OPTION 2 - COLLEGE CREDIT COURSE**

Upon successful completion of CHD 145, Teaching Art, Music and Movement to Children, individuals become eligible for the VDSS Early Childhood Endorsement I - Creativity Series.

#### To achieve the Early Childhood Endorsement I:

- 1. **Complete** CHD 145, Teaching Art, Music and Movement to Children. You must receive a passing grade to qualify for the endorsement.
- 2. **Complete** Early Childhood Endorsement I Creativity Series Application Form
- 3. Submit materials to CCAVA:
  - ✓ Early Childhood Endorsement I Creativity Series Application Form
  - ✓ A copy of your college transcript indicating completion of the course or a Letter of Completion from your instructor.
