

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **What Can SNAPET Offer Me?**

At no cost to you, the program can provide opportunities that, depending on locality, can help with:

- Job Search
- Job Readiness
- Vocational Training
- Education
- Work Experience
- Transportation and other work related costs
- Referrals to other community services

### **How Do I Enroll?**

First, you meet with a staff person to talk about what your goals are and determine what you need to help you reach these goals. A Plan of Participation is completed to provide structure and guide you towards your goals. The SNAPET worker and you work together in designing a program that will help you get to the ultimate goal, employment.

### **Can I Lose My SNAP Benefits?**

SNAPET is a voluntary program; therefore, your SNAP benefits will not be impacted if you do not complete assigned SNAPET activities. However, if you do not comply with requirements, your SNAPET case can be closed and the ability to receive help with transportation and other supportive services will end.
