



Qualifying SNAP recipients can now purchase meals at approved restaurants

The Virginia Department of Social Services, in partnership with the United States Department of Agriculture, is working to make it easier for qualifying SNAP households to have greater access to hot, prepared meals in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Virginia SNAP households who are 60 or older, permanently disabled or experiencing homelessness can purchase prepared meals using their EBT card at approved restaurants through the new **Virginia Restaurant Meals Program (VRMP)**. Just look for the designated VRMP signage displayed within a participating restaurant.

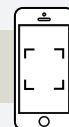
Will participating affect my benefits?

This program will not affect SNAP recipients' benefits in any way, other than providing an additional way of utilizing them. Eligible households will continue to receive their normal issuance of monthly benefits.
