Virginia's Health and Safety Training Course

NOW AVAILABLE - "Virginia Preservice Training for Child Care Staff." This new, **FREE**, 10-hour course introduces child care staff to important health and safety information. Completion of the training is required for all staff who work in a program that participates in the Virginia Child Care Subsidy Program. However, all child care staff working in a child care program in Virginia are *welcome and strongly encouraged* to take this FREE course.

(Please check with your employer to determine if you are required to complete this training and/or additional training.)
