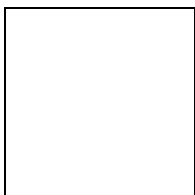


Section IV. No Asbestos Detected

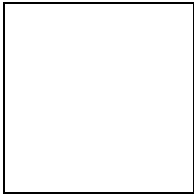

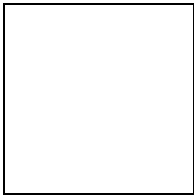


Section VI. Asbestos Removed
