As a reminder, Virginia law changed July 1, 2016 making a conviction of an offense that results in the person's requirement to register with the Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry pursuant to § 9.1-901, or any similar registry in any other state a barrier crime. The list of crimes that convictions of which require registration in the Sex Offender Registry is found at: http://www.dss.virginia.gov/files/division/licensing/cp/intro_page/current_providers/background_investigations/convictions_req_reg_in_the_sex_offender_and_crimes_against_minors_registry.pdf
