## VDSS to continue to pay for fingerprinting

The Virginia Department of Social Services (VDSS) will continue to cover the cost of fingerprint based criminal history searches for those individuals in child day programs who are required to be fingerprinted. The decision has been made to use these funds to ease the financial burden the background check safety requirements has placed on child care programs.

VDSS will pay for fingerprint based criminal history searches through September 30, 2020. This means that VDSS will cover these fees for child care programs:

Employees, applicants, agents, caregivers, approved providers in a family day system, household members	\$59.00
Volunteers	\$39.00

Beginning October 1, 2020, child care providers will be responsible for these fees, so please use this time to budget accordingly.
