Virginia AmeriCorps Programs Ready to Serve

AmeriCorps swearing in ceremony Oct. 16 kicks off year of volunteer service

Virginia AmeriCorps members who were nominated for the third annual Robert E. Wone Award for Exemplary Service will be honored at the ceremony. The award was established in memory of Robert E. Wone, a former member of the Virginia Governor's Commission on Community and National Service (2002-06). The recognition is presented to AmeriCorps member who has exhibited outstanding civic engagement and community service.

WHY: AmeriCorps is a network of service programs that connects more than 70,000 Americans each year in intensive service to meet our country's critical needs in education, public safety, health, and the environment.

AmeriCorps members receive an education stipend of up to \$5,350 that can be used to pay for college or to pay back qualified student loans. Since 1994, more than **7,300** Virginia residents have qualified for AmeriCorps Education Awards totaling more than **\$25,400,000**.
