

**CHILD ABUSE/NEGLECT STATEWIDE STATISTICAL SUMMARY**  
Virginia, July 1, 2000 – June 30, 2001

26,686 Reports of suspected child abuse/neglect were completed by local departments of social services.  
5,963 reports were investigated and determined to be Founded.  
19,607 reports were investigated and determined to be Unfounded.  
1,116 reports were placed in the Assessment Response Track through the Multiple Response System pilots in five local departments of social services.

39,507 Children were reported as being abused or neglected.  
8,993 children were in reports with Founded dispositions.  
28,721 children were in reports with Unfounded dispositions.  
1,793 children were in reports that received an Assessment Response through the Multiple Response System.

Of the Children in Founded Reports:

53% were Female.

47% were Male.

57% were White.

39% were Black.

1% were Asian.

<1% were Other races

2% were Multi-race.

32,486 Caretakers were reported as suspected abusers/neglectors  
7,435 caretakers were in reports with Founded dispositions.  
23,687 caretakers were in reports with Unfounded dispositions.  
1,364 caretakers were in reports that received an Assessment Response through the Multiple Response System.

31 Children died as a result of child abuse/neglect.
