

CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT STATISTICAL SUMMARY

Commonwealth of Virginia, July 1, 2004 – June 30, 2005

30,507 Reports of suspected child abuse/neglect were completed by local departments of social services.

4,661 reports were investigated and determined to be Founded.

7,093 reports were investigated and determined to be Unfounded.

18,753 reports were placed in the Family Assessment Response track.

45,078 Children were reported as being abused or neglected.

7,011 children were in reports with Founded dispositions.

10,031 children were in reports with Unfounded dispositions.

28,036 children were in reports that received a Family Assessment response.

38,915 Caretakers were reported as suspected abusers/neglectors

6,246 caretakers were in reports with Founded dispositions.

9,097 caretakers were in reports with Unfounded dispositions.

23,572 caretakers were in reports that received a Family Assessment.

26 Children died as a result of child abuse/neglect.
