

VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES (VDSS) NEIGHBORHOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (NAP) APPLICATION REVIEW WEBINAR

The Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP) will be accepting applications beginning March 15, 2021. The completed application package must be submitted via the VDSS NAP online database by 5:00 p.m. on May 3, 2021. A sample application, application instructions and the Application – Frequently Asked Questions document will be available online at <https://www.dss.virginia.gov/community/nap.cgi> beginning March 1, 2021.

A NAP application webinar has been scheduled for **Wednesday, March 10, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.** During the webinar, staff will review the VDSS application process and answer any questions for completing the application. The webinar will last approximately two hours depending on questions.

This year, a representative from the Department of Education (DOE) will be joining the meeting to provide a brief summary on the eligibility criteria for applicants interested in applying for NAP tax credits from DOE. Send an email to tax.credits@doe.virginia.gov for all questions relating to education tax credits or to request a copy of the DOE NAP application.

Keep in mind, an organization may only submit one application for NAP tax credits depending on the type of programs the organization offers.
