RE: Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act and AG recipients

The CARES Act signed into law on March 27, 2020, provides a one-time, \$1,200 Economic Impact Payment (EIP) to individuals, including individuals who receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and other Social Security beneficiaries. Individuals with dependents under the age of 17 may also receive \$500 if they meet certain qualifications. See additional information about EIP at: www.irs.gov/coronavirus/economic-impact-payments

The EIP belongs to the AG recipient and is to be used by the recipient for the recipient's personal needs, including but not limited to sodas, snacks, postage stamps, and over-the-counter medications as described in AG regulations, [22 VAC 30-80-40](#).

ALFs that perform safekeeping assistance of residents' funds or manage residents' accounts must have written permission from the individual to do so and provide a monthly statement pursuant to Department of Social Services (DSS) regulations 22VAC40-73-400.

The EIP is not to be used for a private room or basic services that are already covered by the AG payment. It should not be used to cover operating expenses incurred by the facility due to COVID-19.
