PIP Monthly Measures

REQUIRED MONTHLY DATA FROM ALL STATES

1:1 RATIO

- Count of all children who were in foster care on the last day of the month (denominator) to the count of homes available to those children (numerator).

RECENT MALTREATMENT HISTORY

- # of children with a founded/indicated maltreatment report in month also had another founded/indicated report in the past 182 days.

MAINTAINING FAMILY CONNECTIONS

- Children in foster care who are living with relatives at the end of each month.

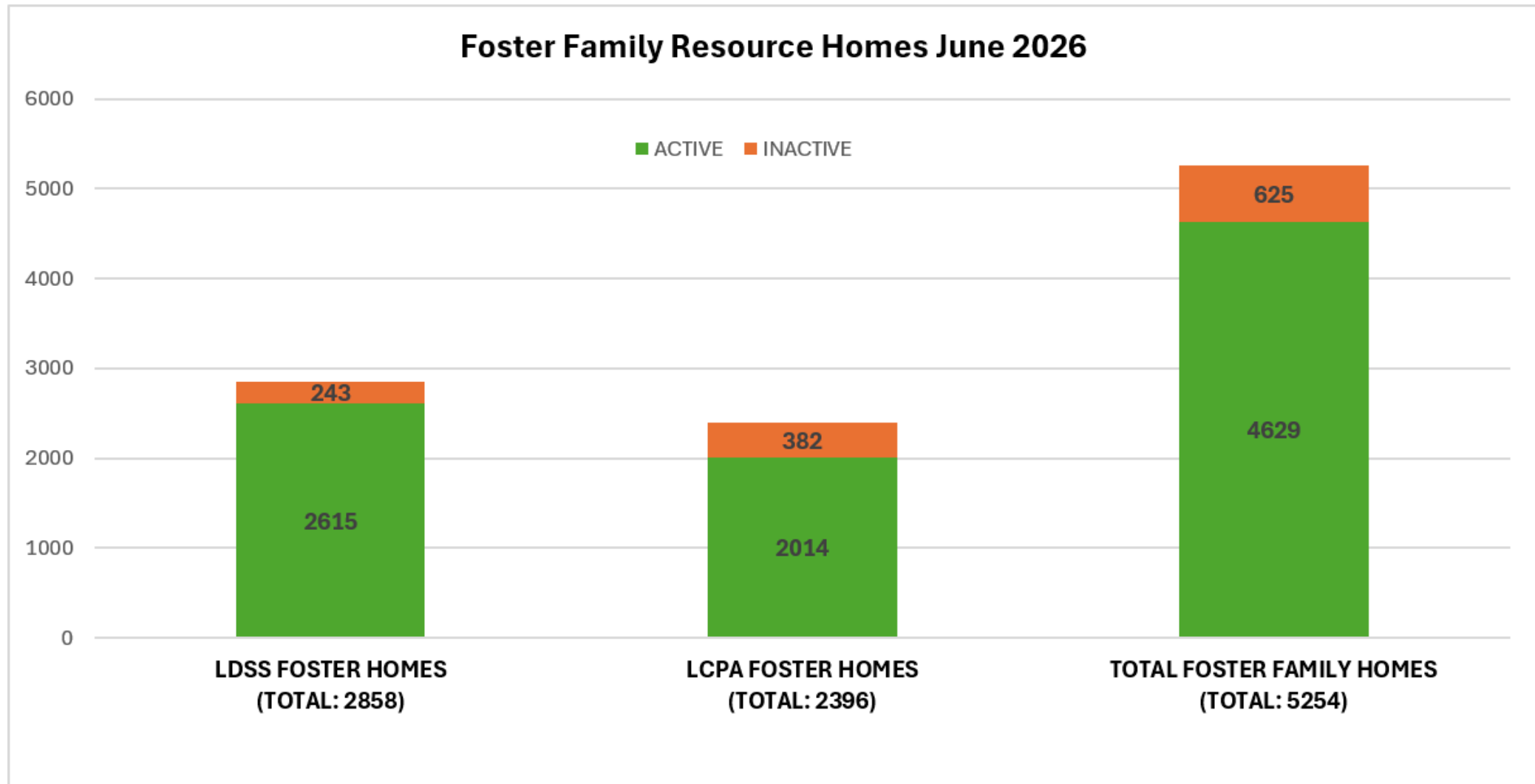
CONGREGATE CARE

- Total days children spent in congregate care each month.

HOME DISRUPTIONS

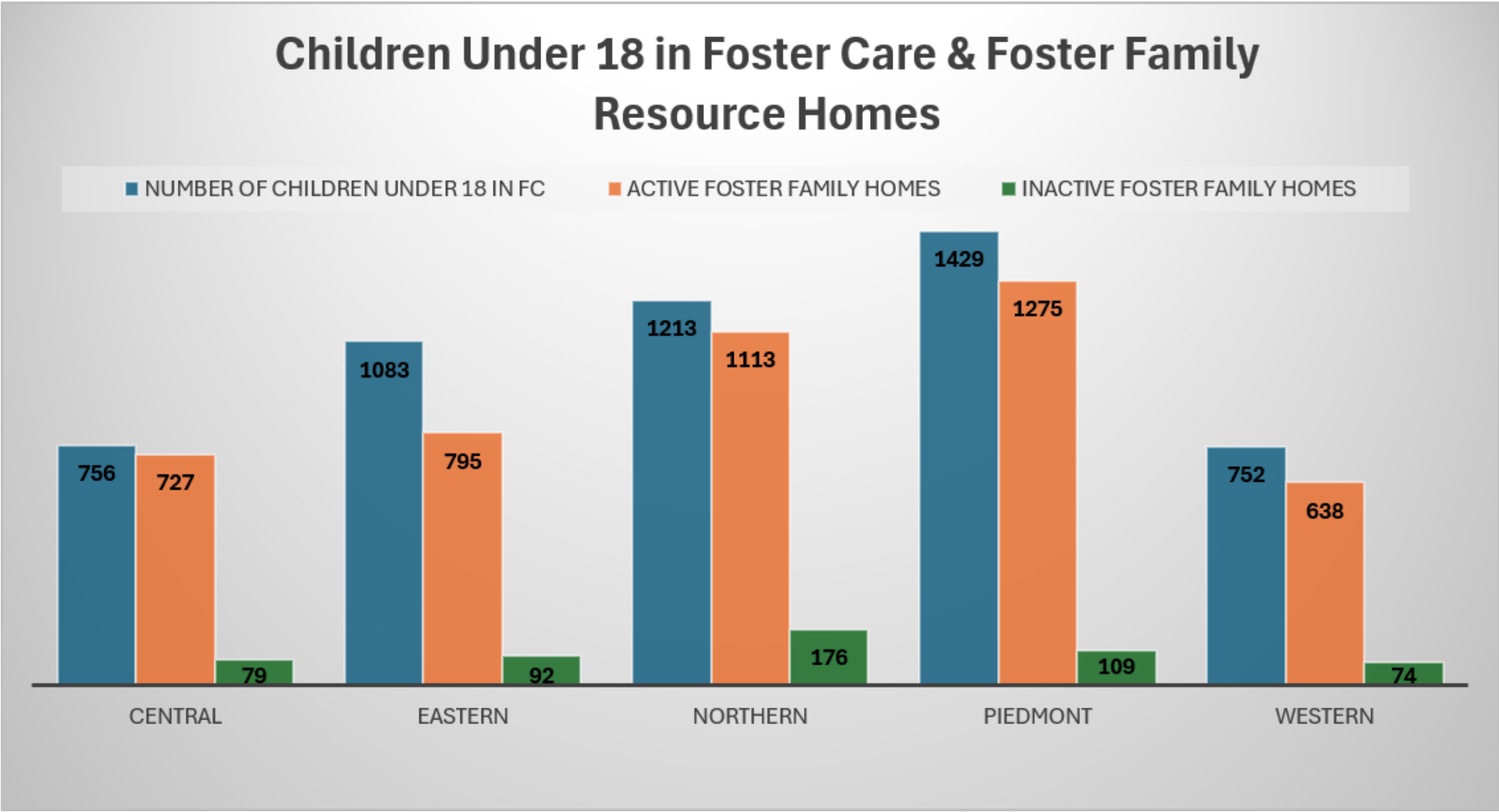
- # of foster homes where a child moved out each month for reasons other than exiting care or starting a trial home visit.

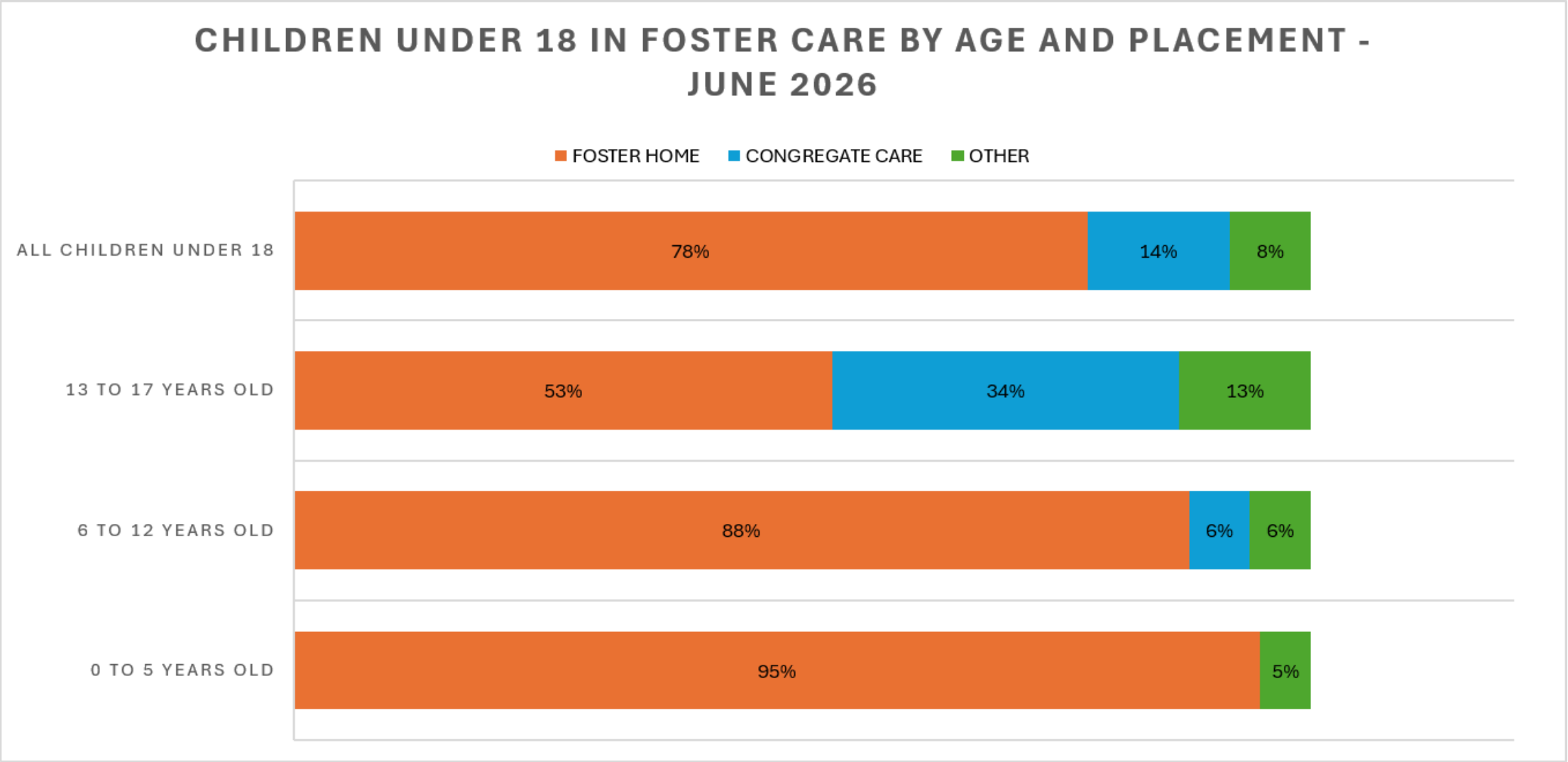
Foster Family Homes & Children in Foster Care by Region
